Theodora Vischer, Senior Curator of Fondation Beyeler, Basel

A group exhibition featuring the artists will be on view from **August 16, 2019 to February 16, 2020** at Hamburger Bahnhof – Museum für Gegenwart – Berlin. The second jury will choose the winner of the prize on September 12, 2019. The award consists of a solo exhibition and an accompanying publication in one of the Nationalgalerie's venues during the course of the year 2020.
